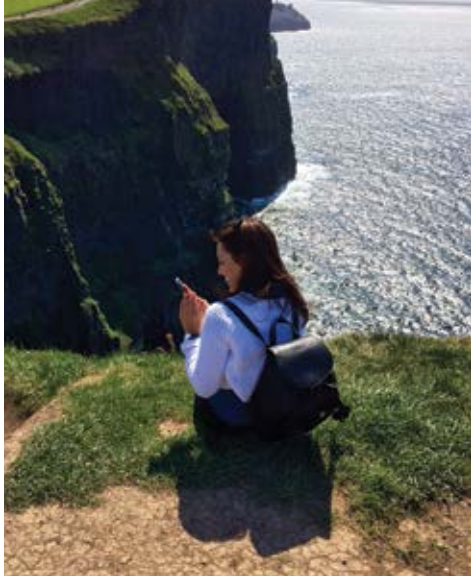
Galway City & Cliffs of Moher
